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Article I. SPECTATOR GUIDELINES

- Masks are recommended but are optional if you are fully vaccinated.
- If you are not vaccinated, you must wear a mask and social distance.
- People (players, coaches, officials, spectators, etc.) feeling sick or that have been exposed to someone sick, should not attend or participate.
- All attendees that show symptoms will be asked to leave the event.
- Teams may be subject to disqualification for the rest of the event if a player or rostered staff show symptoms or test positive for COVID-19.
 - Our medical personnel onsite will make the final decision if a participant or attendee is not cleared to return to the facility due to COVID symptoms.
- Wash and sanitize your hands often.
 - Additional hand sanitizer and hand washing stations will be available throughout the facility.
- We encourage attendees to bring their own hand sanitizer.
- KRVA/USAV request that those meeting the CDC's definition of "at risk" reconsider their attendance.
- The Facility does have a parking fee.

Article II. TICKETS WRISTBANDS

- Tickets/Wristbands will be available for sale on Friday during team check in (6-8pm) and SAT/SUN/MON starting at 7 am
- \$25 event band or \$15 per day

Article III. TEAM GUIDELINES

- Teams and spectators are NOT to switch benches between sets.
- Teams are responsible for bring their own warm up balls.
- When you are the work team, a rostered an adult must be the R2.
- Hand whistles are recommended.
- Game balls will be provided and disinfected upon request.
- 2022 Qualifier tie breaker procedure will be followed.

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Article IV. TEAM CHECK IN

- COACHES/CLUB DIRECTORS must attend in person TEAM CHECK IN on Friday in Room #1 to pick up your official rosters and credentials/bag tags. Times will be announced 1 week prior to the event.
- Rosters MUST be checked in-online on Friday between 10 AM and 5:30 PM
 - VERY IMPORTANT: Credentials/bag tags are for the players and staff on the roster ONLY. Falsification or if used by a spectator not on the roster, team will be subject to \$100 fine or 10 point penalty on next match.
- Roster changes that need to be made after it has been checked in online, may be subject to a Roster Change Fee

Article V. AWARDS

The top three finishers in each Gold Division will receive Medals for each player on the roster. All other Division winners will receive medals for each member of the team on the roster. These can be picked up in team room #1.

It is the obligation of the head coach to be aware of his/her individual State High School Association rules regarding the acceptance of awards. If necessary, present the properly signed papers as required by your State High School Activities Association. This will prevent a delay in the actual presentation of the awards at the Event.

Teams who win a bid will sign their acceptance or decline form here.

Article VI. TEAM FORFEITURES

In addition to the penalties in the Boys Championship Manual, Forfeiting Teams will be subject to a fine of \$1,000 paid to the Event.

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
