


On-Court Training

Focus is on training, not evaluation.


Remember: Everyone makes mistakes...and that's ok!

- Current USAV Rules Book and current USAV Casebook





- You work for you! You can work as much or as little as you want.
 - 2 region days to maintain your certification

Payment & Perks

- Pay per match: \$45 per match
